

The following additional information is provided by Pat McCabe, who is coordinating all the facilities, stalling, etc. For further information or specific questions please call Pat at 563-543-4177 or Lacey at 563-543-5251.

Stalling- All cattle will be stalling on the north side of each aisle with free tack space on the south side behind your cattle. Extra space is also available for chutes and feed in the extra unbedded area of each aisle. Electricity is plentiful and will be no need for generators. No butt fans or aisle fans are allowed and to maximize air flow please face all fans to blow air from west to east.

Parking- All trailers will be parked in Dean Lot which is across the street from Fairgrounds on the south side. Vehicle parking will be mainly in Lot L which is east of the cattle barn.

Reminder- all streets inside the fairgrounds are city streets. To avoid possible tickets be sure to adhere to One-way streets, No Parking , Handicap signs, etc.

Golf Carts- anyone bringing such vehicle must register it with the Iowa State Fair Public Safety Office- 563-262-3111 Ext 312.

Tie Outs- Will be bedded with chips. No other bedding is allowed in barns or tie outs.

Arrival- The soonest we are allowed into the tie out gate (Gate 6 off of Dean Ave) is 3:00 pm Sunday. We will be allowed to take trailers and vehicles to the barn area also yet Sunday. Traffic control has committed to that being 6:00 pm and it might be sooner.

Late Sunday Arrivals- Please let Pat or Lacey know if you will be arriving after dark on Sunday evening and we will be sure to have someone at the tie out gate to assist you, the barn may be locked and if you want to set up yet Sunday night we will make arrangements.
