A large crowd gathered for Beastrom Gelbvieh's annual bull sale at Ft. Pierre Livestock. The quality was excellent top to bottom for the Gelbvieh and Balance bull offering.

Topping the sale at \$6,500 was Lot 1, BEA Sureshock 705T ET. This homozygous black Balancer bull earned Reserve Division honors at the 2008 National Western. Jumping Cow Gelbvieh of Colorado was the buyer of this BEA Johnny Walker 353R son.

Next high seller was Lot 76, BEA 687S, a homozygous black polled purebred son of SSL Platinum. Post Rock Cattle Company of Barnard, Kan., was the buyer at \$5,750.

Randy Kleinschmidt of Grafton, Neb., bought Lot 49, BABR 753T. This polled homozygous black Balancer, a son of EXAR Pay Stub, sold for \$3,900.

Longtime buyer, Jeff Bush from Pierre, bid \$3,750 for Lot 2. This black, polled purebred bull is sired by BEA Johnny Walker 353R out of a Fearless daughter.

Rounding out the top sellers was Gerald Smith of Wineglass Bar Ranch in Lewiston, Utah. He bid \$3,250 for Lot 20, a black polled purebred son of SSL Platinum.

Volume buyers included Donald Klinkner, Artesian, six head; Denny Volek, Highmore, five head; and Aldeen Ebel, Herried, five head.
