A standing room only crowd was on hand for the 30th Annual Judd Ranch Bull Sale. Eighty plus percent of the bull offering was powerhouse purebred Gelbvieh bulls with the balance being purebred Red Angus bulls and Balancer bulls.

Lot 137, JRI Top Grid 254T725 topped the sale offering at \$10,000. Top Grid was a Breeder's Choice Gelbvieh Bull Futurity Runner-Up and the lead bull in Judd Ranch's Champion Pen of Five Gelbvieh Bulls. This black polled purebred Gelbvieh is a son of JRI Top Secret and posted a 39.6 cm yearling scrotal and a 124 gain test ratio. He also posted a 16.9 square inch ribeye with 4 plus marbling score. Leonhardt Cattle Company of Lake Preston, S.D., added this herd bull.

\$8,500—Lot 141—JRI Top Gun 254T752, a black polled purebred son of Top Secret sold Dean and June Zimmerman of Mt. View, Okla.

\$7,000—JRI Secret Weapon 164T5, a black polled purebred Top Secret son and a third member of the Champion Pen of Five sold to Ivers Family of Austin, Minn.

\$6,500—JRI Frontier 293T4, a member of the Judd Ranch Champion Pen of Three Bulls. He sold to Lewis Farms, Monticello, Ky.

\$6,200—JRI Magnum 207S63 topped the fall yearling offering. Magnum is a black polled Top Secret son. Lewis Farms also bought this powerhouse.
