The quality was top notch and the bidding active at the 2007 Greater Montana Gelbvieh Female Sale.

Topping the sale was Lot 27, RTRM Temptation ET, consigned by Tom and Megan Rea of Berthoud, Colo. Temptation is a January 2007 daughter of XXB Titus 880K out of the 2004 Reserve National Champion Female, BTI Miss Kali B 2126M. She sold for \$3,250 to Triple M Gelbvieh of Colorado.

The next high seller and high selling bred female was Lot 2, CJLL Sweet Sue S08 from CJ&L Livestock of Hermosa, S.D. Sweet Sue is a February 2006 daughter of OZZ EXT Govenor and sold bred to VRT Lazy TV Beethoven K278. S R Graveley Gelbvieh of Avon was the winning bidder at \$3,100.

Following closely at \$3,000 was a bred heifer from Kicking Horse Ranch of Oilmont. KHR 652S is a homozygous black purebred daughter of KHR Midland 38N and sold bred to MLH Strait Forward. Goettlich Gelbvieh Ranch of Hilger had the top bid.

Lot 20, a bred heifer from Middle Creek Farms slid into the next high selling spot at \$2,400. This homozygous black Balancer female sired by MCFG MCF Bruce Almighty 35P ET sold bred to Montana Infusion. Pine Ridge Gelbvieh of Lewistown was the buyer.

Other top sellers include:

Lot 21: \$2,100—an open Balancer heifer consigned by Pine Ridge Gelbvieh sold to Middle Creek Farms & Danell Diamond Six Ranch. Sired by Connealy Danny Boy out of a Flying H Exclusive daughter.

Lot 29: \$2,000—JNL Blanca 2002T, an open Balancer heifer sired by BT Rolls Royce 218P out of an SLC Empire 41E dam. Consigned by John Carrel and sold to Jumping Cow Gelbvieh of Colorado.

Lot 23: \$2,000—the Montana Heifer Futurity winner, MHD Teva 88T from M Heart D Gelbvieh of Stevensville. She is a double black open heifer sired by MCFG MCF Bruce Almighty 35P ET and sold to Goettlich Gelbvieh Ranch. As futurity winner, Teva earned a \$3,420 paycheck for M Heart D.
