A tremendous crowd was on hand for the annual Judd Ranch Cow Power Female Sale. At the end of the day, one of the best Judd female sales ever was in the books.

Topping the offering was Lot 46, JRI Ms Style Review 214P60, a red polled purebred daughter of JRI Black N Stacked 270M78 out of a JEB Polled Gizmo 17Z daughter. Kelly Leonhardt of Leonhardt Cattle Company in South Dakota bid \$5,500 to own this female selling bred to JRI Extra Exposure 285L71 ET. Kelly also took home Lot 50, JRI Ms Sensational 214N51, for a bid of \$4,200. This double polled purebred bred female out of JRI Pld Free Agent 125J3 sold bred to JRI Extra Exposure.

Kanhoma Ranch of Coffeyville, Kan., bid \$5,000 for Lot 33 to slip into the next high seller slot. JRI Ms Real Treasurer 207L57 is a homozygous black, double polled purebred daughter of JBOB Carolina Choice 2163J out of a POW Jetstream 36B daughter. She sold bred to JRI Top Secret 253M75 ET.
