Topping the Seedstock Plus sale offering on a Friday evening in Keosauqua was Lot 595, a red double polled purebred Gelbvieh bull, JEB BCC Reckless 64S. Burbank Cattle Company of St. Catharine, Mo., consigned this KCF Bennett P161 son. Knoles Stock Farm of Mason City, Ill., had the winning bid at \$3,100.

Burbank Cattle Company also had the other high purebred bull at \$2,500. Another red polled son of KCF Bennett P161, Tom LeCuyer of Morrowville, Kan., was the buyer.

Leading the Balancer consignments was Lot 579, JEB BCC Balance 12S, a red double polled son of RAB Bieber Make Mimi. Tom LeCuyer of Kansas was the buyer at \$2,800.

Lot 580, another red polled Balancer son of RAB Bieber Make Mimi from Burbank Cattle Company caught the eye of Gary Franklin of Keosauqua at \$2,600.

Olson Acres LTD of Grand Mound consigned the top selling Angus bull. This son of Sydgen Directive 3468 sold to Arnold Farms of Russell for \$1,900.
