Topping the sale for the day was Lot 620, a Balancer consigned by Thousand Oaks Ranch of Paris, Texas. Stuecken Brothers Gelbvieh of Freeburg purchased this 18-month-old homozygous black, double polled son of KCF Bennett Landmark J377 for a final bid of \$4,500.

Thousand Oaks Ranch also had the second high selling lot of the day. Lot 630 was a homozygous black, double polled Balancer sired by KCF Bennett Kingpin K403. Terry Baker of Newburg was the winning bidder at \$4,050.

Topping the Gelbvieh division for the day was Lot 780, HFGC HF Black Bart 401T26, from Hart Farm of Kansas City, Kan. This black, homozygous polled son of RTRM Headline sold to Davidson Brothers Gelbvieh of McCune, Kan., for \$3,500.

Lots 763 and Lot 737 tied for second high selling honors in the Gelbvieh lineup. Both sold for \$3,300. Lot 763, a homozygous black, double polled Carolina Fortune 3956L ET son from White Brothers of Topeka, Kan., sold to Lynn and Ann Gregory of Edna. Lot 737 is a Carolina Fortune son from Steffensen J5 Cattle Co. of Gainesville and he sold to Bruce Peters of Zononi.

Prairie Creek Angus of Pleasant Plains, Ill., consigned the top two Angus high sellers. Both were 4G Regulator sons. Chance Koppenhaver of Oxford, Iowa, paid \$2,900 for Lot 601, while Ervin Eicher of Sarcoxie paid \$2,400 for Lot 606.

The top spring bred heifer was a Balancer heifer from Sandy Knoll Farm Gelbvieh of St. John, Kan. This KCF Bennett K503 ET daughter sold bred to Dunn's New Level 025S. Bradley McWilliams of Asbury bought the heifer for \$2,200.

Jeremy and Lisa Bryant of Huntsville, Ark., bought the high selling fall pair for \$1,775. Mulroy Farms of Kansas consigned the Pauls Traveler 713 Angus female, bred back to a Balancer bull, and her OZZ EXT Govenor 3N heifer calf at side.

White Brothers consigned the high selling spring pair for \$2,100. Lot 844 is a black GDW Blk Jim daughter with a black February heifer calf at side by ELK CK Kipp 440S. Garrett Sikes of Viola, Ark., was the winning bidder.

Sikes struck again and bought the top selling fall bred female. Lot 794, also a White Brothers consignment, is a red GJHG Cool Drew daughter and she sold bred to ELK CK Kipp 440S for \$1,475.

Flint Hills Gelbvieh of Alma, Kan., consigned the high selling spring open heifer, a DPWG Will daughter. Kerry Brooks of Cassville was the buyer at \$1,300.
