Cold weather and icy roads kept some folks away but the stands were full of commercial and seedstock producers for the Gelbvieh and Balancer sale at the Black Hills Stock Show in Rapid City, S.D.

Topping the sale was Lot 14, ELK CK Formula 957S, a black purebred son of ELK CK Maverick, consigned by Elk Creek Gelbvieh of Piedmont. Prairie Hills Gelbvieh of Gladstone, N.D., bid \$7,250 to own this long bodied, thick made bull.

Tying for top selling honors was the Grand Champion Gelbvieh/Balancer Female from Beastrom Gelbvieh of Pierre, S.D. This bred Balancer female easily won the show and went on to be named Supreme Champion Female over all breeds later in the week. Wattis Ranch of Casper, Wyo., bid \$7,250 to own this TMAS TMAS Mr Cherokee 312 daughter.

Prairie Hills Gelbvieh of North Dakota consigned the next high seller, Lot 21, a March 2006 son of LJSA Buster 239M. This red polled purebred posted five stars for tenderness and went to Golden Buckle Gelbvieh in Medina, N.D., for \$5,100.

The Grand Champion Gelbvieh/Balancer Bull was EGL Chisum S027, a black polled son of EGL Fosters L017 ET. Eagle Pass Ranch of Highmore consigned this bull that earned a bid of \$4,750.

Rounding out the top sellers was Lot 18 from Goldux Gelbvieh of Wessington. This SPUR Beretta 703G son caught the eye of many during the show. Handel Farms of Menno had the winning bid at \$4,600.
