The Judd Ranch 16th Annual Cow Power Sale drew another large crowd on a perfect fall day. Cattle sold into 12 states. The junior judging contest held sale morning also drew a nice group of young cattle enthusiasts. The winners received sale credit, Judd Ranch hats and certificates, with many of the young people using their sale credits.

Topping the sale at \$4,000 was Lot 29A, JRI Ms Top Secret 291S7. This February 22, 2006 daughter of JRI Top Secret 253M75 is out of JRI Ms X' and O's 291N6. Kevin Davis of Murray, Iowa, was the winning bidder on this double polled purebred heifer calf.

The top seller's dam, Lot 29 JRI Ms X' and O's 291N6, was also in the top sellers at \$3,800. Warfield Farms of Millwood, Va., bought this January 2003 daughter of JRI Pld Free Agent 125J3.

Danny Templeton of Sedalia, Mo., found Lot 3, JRI Ms Love Child 009S5 ET in the sale. He had the winning bid at \$4,000 for this BTI Extra 2106K ET daughter out of WHIT's Love Child.

Chestnut Oak Gelbvieh Farm of Pierce City, Mo., bid \$3,500 to own Lot 53, JRI Ms Show N Tell 125M43, a 2002 daughter of SLC Freedom 178F ET out of JRI Ms Pd Showtime 125H43. Evan Woodbury of Quenemo, Kan., bid \$1,800 to own her heifer calf, JRI Ms Amber 125S54. This purebred heifer calf is sired by JRI Pld Free Agent 125J3.

Larry Brandon II of Murfreesboro, Tenn., bid \$3,000 to own JRI Ms Pld Center Stage 68G6, a double polled purebred bred donor female. She is a '97 model out of JRI Pd Red Rolex 53E61.
