A quality offering awaited the buyers at the 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Ozark Pride Sale. A combined offering from Hartland Farm, Robert and Mona Hart, and J Bar M Gelbvieh, Jon and Edna Miller, this sale is truly one of the best in the Ozarks of southern Missouri.

Topping the sale at \$6,500 was JCGR Bar GT Ms 405M ET, an elite donor from the heart of J Bar M's embryo program. This black SLC Freedom daughter out of BDCG Claudia 1144J sold to Charlie, Jordan & Scott Dieh of Bradford, Ohio.

The second high selling lot came from the Hartland Farm program. RHRT Pinball ET is a homozygous black, homozygous polled KCF Bennett Kingpin son out of JBOB 92C 1373G ET. J Bar M Gelbvieh bid \$5,500 to own this herd sire prospect.

The next two high selling lots were both from the choice of donors from the J Bar M Gelbvieh program. This opportunity gave the buyer the right to flush any of the J Bar M donors offered. Winning the bid at \$4,750, Goose Creek Gelbvieh of Marion, N.C., selected the choice to flush BETZ Magic Muffin F64. Kendall Kilborne of East Bernstadt, Ky., bid \$4,500 to win the right to flush JBOB 2308J.

C-Cross Farm of North Carolina bid \$3,600 for HYEK Graphite 0761K, a HYEK Detonator daughter out of a Post Rock Black Savvy daughter. Chiming in at \$3,500 was Verner Farms of Georgia to purchase Lot 19, a KCF Bennett Ideal daughter out of the high selling female JCGR Bar GT Ms 405M ET.

Jumping Cow Gelbvieh of Colorado bid \$3,300 to own RHRT Samanna ET, a daughter of JCGR Bar GT Mach One 54L out of JBOB 92C 1373G ET.

Rounding out the top sellers at \$3,200 was Lot 45 from the J Bar M Gelbvieh program. LJSA Diamonds is a Flying H Extra 150D daughter out of a TAU Dr. Pepper 29D female. Hart Farm of Kansas City, Kan., purchased this bred female.
