An active bidding crowd attended the annual Genetic Harvest Female Sale hosted by Post Rock Cattle Company. The sale also featured guest consignments from Meadowlark Gelbvieh, Stucky Gelbvieh, Twin Oak Gelbvieh and Dawson Creek Gelbvieh.

Topping the sale at \$4,100 was DCSF Post Rock Diamond 44K2 ET, a homozygous black, homozygous polled daughter of KCF Bennett Ideal out of Post Rock Diamond 25G2, a TLR Cocoa female. This donor pen female sold red to BTI Extra 2106K ET. Brett Bozeman of Georgia bought this tremendous female on the phone.

Randall Farms of South Carolina bid \$3,700 to own Lot 38, DCSF Post Rock Special 85P2. This red, polled purebred female stacked some of the best Gelbvieh sires available with Post Rock Top Brass on the top side and New Direction on the bottom side.

Dromgoole's Heaven of Texas bought the next high selling lot at \$3,200. Lot 65 is a red double polled female from the Dawson Creek program. She is a JRI Extra Exposure female out of a Freedom daughter. She sold bred to BTI Extra 2106K ET.

Roger Overmiller of Smith Center bid \$3,100 to own Lot 24, MLG Meadowlarks Kathryn. This black polled female sold as a pair with her fall-born calf at side sired by Post Rock Top Brass. Kathryn is a daughter of JBOB Black Image.

Johnson Cattle Company of Texas bid \$3,000 for a homozygous black, homozygous polled Balancer daughter out of the sale's top lot, Post Rock Diamond 44K2. This CA Future Direction daughter put together carcass traits with performance and eye appeal.

Rounding out the top sellers was Carl Reiste of Iowa with a \$3,000 bid for Lot 7B, the choice of a black homozygous polled Bennett Pacesetter daughter or her BTI Extra 2106K ET daughter at side. Reiste selected the February 2006 heifer calf out of DCSF Post Rock Gwen 177K2.
