Joplin Regional Stockyards hosted the Seedstock Plus Fall Bull and Female Sale. A large crowd was on hand for the 169 bulls and 132 females offered.

Topping the bulls was RUMG Kingpin R4, a black, double polled purebred Gelbvieh from Rumfelt Gelbvieh of Conway. Hilltop Farms of Asbury had the winning bid at \$4,400.

Rockin G Farms of Wellston, Okla., consigned the top selling Angus bull, RGFM Captain Creek's Pride, a Future Direction 5321 son. Thomas Tillison of Wellston purchased the bull for \$3,900.

BSRA Double Edge Red from Blue Stone Red Angus of Wisconsin topped the Red Angus offering. Kenn Maples of Maples Farm near Kearney, Mo., bid \$2,850 for the bull.

VanWinkle Farms of Neosho consigned two of the high selling Balancer bulls for the day. VWF Black Beard R4 and VWF Black Billy R1, both DPWG Will sons, are 50 percent Gelbvieh-50 percent Red Angus. Gilbert Chrisman of Jasper took both home for \$4,000 and \$3,500.

Other top sellers for the day include:

\$3,900: BWF Brandywine Razorback 553R, black double polled Carolina Fortune son from Brandywine Farms of Minnesota. Koellner Brothers of Milton, Iowa, was the buyer.

\$3,600: TMMW Blk Fortune 59R, homozygous black, double polled JBOB Carolina 3956L ET son from Mulroy Farms of Kansas sold to Koellner Brothers of Iowa.

\$2,700: MOEL Nia N022, a black purebred Gelbvieh fall pair form White Brothers of Kansas sold to Buddy Enyart of Wyandotte, Okla.

\$2,600: TOP Ms Advancer K232 P419, black purebred daughter of KCF Bennett Advancer sold with twin Balancer heifer calves at side by Bon View New Design 878. Waller Gelbvieh of Kansas consigned the female purchased by Gordon Fristoe of Odessa.

\$2,550: CPGG TSR Ms Prairie Rhoda a black purebred Gelbvieh from Two Step Gelbvieh of Iowa sold bred to XXB Drew 565K for a spring calf. Perry McKinley of Oklahoma was the buyer.
