The sixth edition of the Bluegrass Invitational Sale proved a popular source of quality Gelbvieh genetics. This annual event drew a large gathering at Mt. Sterling with many first-time buyers. Topping the sale at \$3,800 was Lot 37, KIT Jenna N29. Pleasant Meadows Farm at Glasgow consigned this powerful female. Single Tree Farm of Edmonton was the successful bidder.

Close behind was Lot 40/40A at \$3,600. S & S Gelbvieh consigned this bred WAM Stonewall daughter with a MLH Goldrush Visa bull calf at side. Padon Farms of Salem was the final bidder.

Lot 38/38A was another bred WAM Stonewall daughter with a JBOB "Junior" 3303K ET bull calf at side. Larry Clark of Greensburg snatched this pair up for \$3,100.
