Moved back one week due to the Good Friday holiday, the Midwest Performance Bull Sale breeders brought their best for this Friday evening sale. The Midwest Performance Bull Sale breeders include: Double D Farm, Winslow, Ill.; Horton Gelbvieh, Ft. Dodge, Iowa; J Bar K Cattle Company, Shannon, Ill.; Lone Oak Gelbvieh, Mechanicsville, Iowa; Sienknecht Cattle Company, Gladbrook, Iowa; and Sienknecht Gelbvieh, Clutier, Iowa. The bulls were all fed together on test at Kirkwood Community College in Cedar Rapids.

Topping the sale at \$9,250 was Lot 1 from Horton Gelbvieh. JHG 662S ET is a purebred son of PMG Pegasus 01P out of the LJS Sally donor female. This black, polled bull had bidders in the seats and on the phone. Dromgoole's Heaven of Richmond, Texas, was the winning bidder.

Sliding into the next high seller slot was Lot 15, a Balancer bull from Sienknecht Cattle Company & Sienknecht Gelbvieh. This JBOB 4665M son went home with Don Anderson of Wellsburg for a bid of \$4,800.

Bee Lick Gelbvieh Farm of Kentucky bought the next high seller at \$4,000. The Lot 18 bull is a purebred son of XXB Titus 880K from Horton Gelbvieh. This homozygous black bull is out of a first calf heifer.
