The Seedstock Plus Eastern Colorado Sale moved from its mid-March date to mid-April with the harsh winter that faced producers on the eastern plains of Colorado. Some greatly needed moisture fell the day before the sale and the buyers were ready to bid on these range-ready bulls.

Topping the sale was RED Fortunate 681S, a black purebred bull from Redland Gelbvieh of Montana. Dennis Gustin of Mandan, N.D., bid \$4,300 for this son of JBOB Carolina Fortune 2564J ET.

The next high selling lot was also a purebred Gelbvieh from Redland Gelbvieh. Lakeview Farms of Fort Collins bid \$3,900 to own RED Bond 655S, a son of GKT Boo Boo 155E.

Three Balancer bulls slid into the next high selling slots. J&D Kerstiens of Indiana sold JDKG Kerstiens 271R, a son of JD Daigger 901, to Jim Stone of Hugo for \$3,750. SEGA Gelbvieh of Pierce offered up SEGA Six Gun 685S, a son of YCC Alliance 45. Sandy Knoll Farms of St. John, Kan., bid \$3,200 to own Six Gun.

Rounding out the Balancer top sellers was another entry from J&D Kerstiens. JDKG Kerstiens 283R, a BR Midland son, caught the eye of Kenny Everitt of Grover for \$3,100.

Clayton Cattle Company sold two Angus bulls for \$2,500 each. A Morgan's Direction 111 9901 son sold to Ken Lindholm of Eads, while a GAR Yield Grade son sold to Warren McDonald of Weston.
