The tenth edition of the South Carolina Gelbvieh Association South Dream Sale featured one of the best quality and deepest sets of females in the sale's history. A warm spring day greeted buyers and the cattle were in fine shape.

Topping the sale was Lot 12 from Country Boy Farms of Edgefield. This KCF Bennett Landmark daughter out of an SLC Freedom daughter sold with a JBOB "Junior" 3303K ET heifer calf at side. Wagner Performance Cattle of Georgia bid \$3,600 on the pair.

Sliding in at \$3,500 was Lot 19 from Broad River Gelbvieh of Lavonia, Ga. This Bon View New Design 878 Balancer female sold with a homozygous black, homozygous polled heifer calf at side by XXB Drew. Stinson Cattle Company of Berryton, Kan., was the winning bidder.

Flying H Genetics-North Carolina Division consigned the next high seller. Lot 33, a GKT Boo Boo daughter out of an M/L Encore dam went to Broad River Gelbvieh for \$3,450.
