The Southern Belles Gelbvieh Production sale featured top quality lots from four consignors: Verner Farms, Georgia; Partisover Ranch, Georgia; Wagner Performance Cattle, Georgia; and Pleasant Meadows Farm, Kentucky. The quality ran deep for purebred and Balancer females at this inaugural event.

Topping the sale at \$7,300 was PRTY Partisover Julia 441N ET, a homozygous black, homozygous polled Balancer female. M&P Gelbvieh of Nebraska and Mohogany Hollow Gelbvieh of Utah joined forces to own this daughter of Twin Valley Precision E161 out of JBOB "Miss Julia" 2417J ET.

PRTY Partisover Playmate 593R ET, a January 2005 daughter of Miss Julia out of the popular Angus sire, GAR Integrity sold to J Bar M Gelbvieh of Missouri for \$6,000.

J Bar M Gelbvieh struck again for the next high seller at \$5,100 for half embryo interest for the life of the cow for Lot 6, VER Miss Flotos Echo 840J1 ET. This CTR Echo daughter is out of a Floto dam.

Also chiming in at a \$5,100 bid was Jumping Cow Gelbvieh of Colorado purchasing a flush opportunity on VER Lee Ann 309M ET, a Leachman Saugahatchee 3000C daughter out of the LWGR Lee Ann 79D 751G ET cow.

Dromgoole's Heaven took advantage of the Verner donor pen and bid \$4,800 for the right to flush LWGR Lee Ann 79D 751G ET.
