Topping the sale was Lot 1, HYEK Black Impact 3960N. This sire serves as the main Gelbvieh herd sire for the Hostert operation. Cedar Top Ranch of Stapleton, Neb., and DMD Livestock of Beaver City, Neb., bid \$5,500 for spring possession of this homozygous black, homozygous polled purebred son of HYEK Black Impulse 1296L.
