**DATE SENT: JAN. 1**

**DATE DUE: MARCH 15**

**Purpose:**

- Part of Total Herd Reporting
- Provide data to more accurately make genetic predictions
- Register offspring born between Jan. 1- July 31
- See next page for important codes

**Consequences if Late:**

- Deactivation of Cows, which requires fee to be paid before being reactivated.
- Membership is deactivated

## Annual Herd Assessments & Spring Calf Registration

**DATE DUE: APRIL 1**

**Purpose:**

- Identifies Genetic Trends
- Establishes Genetic Trait Leaders, Genetic Indicator Sires, and Progeny Tested Sires.

**DATE DUE: APRIL 15**

**Purpose:**

- Part of Total Herd Reporting
- Report calves born Jan. 1 - July 31 of the previous year
- See next page for important codes

**Consequences if Late:**

- Traditional registration fees must be paid, one-rate credit is lost.

## One-Rate Spring Calves

**DATE DUE: AUGUST 1**

**Purpose:**

- Honors Dams with proven longevity and productivity

**Dam of Merit Criteria**

Produced at least 3 calves, all with weaning information reported to the AGA

**Dam of Distinction Criteria**

Produced at least 8 calves, all with weaning information reported to the AGA



# Total Herd Reporting - Important Dates

**DATE SENT: JUNE 30**

**DATE DUE: JULY 31**

**Purpose:**

- Part of Total Herd Reporting
- Sent to all cows who report a reproductive status code "G", indicating they calved after July 31 of the previous year
- See below for important codes

**Consequences if Late:**

- Deactivation of Cows, which requires fee to be paid before being reactivated.

- F. Cow had no Calf in current year, cow shifted calving season
- G. Cow calved after July 31 of Previous year
- H. Cow had no Calf in current year, other
- W. Cow had a calf in current year, died prior to weaning, no calf data available
- X. Cow had a calf in past year, calf information enclosed or already submitted to AGA

### Disposal Codes

- 1. Died on Arrival - difficulty calving
